ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY

John Gable worked for MnDOT and was most notably the project manager for the Stone Arch Bridge project that began in the early 90s. He retired in 1993 and died at age 61 in 1994. His wife, Joy, sent the archive some of his pictures after her initial donation of records. Gable's interest in photography began in WWII, when he started saving Life magazines articles. The earliest slides were from 1952, when he was 19 years old. He took glamorous shots of downtown Minneapolis and was fascinated by the Foshay building. He took extension courses at the University of Minnesota. He worked at MNDOT and was involved with I-394 construction work. His pictures appeared in ads, pamphlets, newspaper articles, and newsletters.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection contains the creative, work and education of John Gable. The collection is separated into 5 series.

The first series is his class work from extension courses he took at the University of Minnesota about historic preservation and house research. For one assignment he had to use old mortgages and compile a spreadsheet. This mortgage is in box 1.

The second series is government documents taken from his involvement in I-394. The long title of the report is: Final environmental impact statement & final section 4(F) evaluation US-12/I-394: Between SR-101 & I-94 In Wayzata, Minnetonka, Saint Louis Park, Golden Valley & Minneapolis. This was published in 1982.

The third series is his MNDOT work. He was the Project manager for the Stone Arch Bridge. He was also involved in the I-394, and Third Avenue Bridge.

The fourth series is his published work. I included the Life Magazine articles that were his inspiration from the 1940s and 1964. His photos were in ads, pamphlets, newsletters, and newspapers. His trademark style is long, glamorous, film noir pictures of skyscrapers.

The final series was his oversized pictures, slides and negatives. Two groups of pictures were in the photo room prior to acquisition of the collection. Folder 26, contains number CPH 1.16 pictures of downtown Minneapolis and Gold Medal Park.

The second box contains a 1953-1954 photo album, 3 boxes of slides, 2 boxes of pictures in sleeves and one box containing a mortgage.
