ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY

Milton Schadegg was born in 1908. Little is known about his life. In 1934, he earned an education degree. From 1935-1936, he taught in Akeley High School. From 1938-1941, he was a civics teacher at Central High School in Minneapolis. He went to Harvard and earned a divinity degree. He was a preacher in Arlington, MA. He died in 1996 in Hancock, NH.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The archivist notes series contains restricted folders, the finding aid, research, and other materials related to the collection. This collection is so unique and shows societal attitudes from pre-World War II society and needs to be digitized.

The Akeley Public Schools series is from his time teaching there. The date ranges from 1935-1936.

Carl Laughlin was a regional Artist from Pennsylvania. He gave Milton Schadegg drawings from his time in World War I trenches. The drawings are on 1936 paper.

The correspondence series ranges from 1936-1939 and has correspondence.

The Harvard University series contains academic work in education. The dates range from 1932-1933. The Intelligence Tests are fascinating.

The Lesson Plan series contains two undated Ancient History tests.

The publication series was the second most interesting series in this collection. The materials are not dated except the 1938 graduation pamphlet. The archivist's favorite pamphlet was the Unamerican Activities in Minneapolis.

The Student Paper series is dated prior to World War II and offers a study of societal attitudes prior to World War II.

The Teaching Materials series is undated and has similar content to the Lesson Plan series.

The Teaching Philosophy series contains academic work and is similar to the Harvard University Series.

The Test Series contains copies of tests in the classroom. It is in two boxes: two & three.
