### **ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY**

SEMPACC stands for Southeast Minneapolis Planning & Coordination Committee and will be referred to as SEMPACC throughout this finding aid. SEMPACC was the combined neighborhood organizations of Prospect Park, Como and Marcy-Holmes. The organization was founded in the mid-1960s by a group of individuals, businesses, and churches. According to one of their brochures: "The principal function of SEMPACC is to serve as a clearing house for community relations & the University of Minnesota." In an oral history interview the purpose of SEMPACC was to combine the political party of all three neighborhood organizations.

They were involved in many projects. Some of the notable ones include River Ramble, The University Planning District Citizens Advisory Committee, Holmes Urban renewal, and Motely School Renewal. The archivist thinks SEMPACC was involved in the Neighborhood Rehabilitation Project of the 1970s.

Minneapolis is a city of neighborhoods. Each neighborhood has a distinct feel, look, appeal and association. According to an oral history, these three neighborhoods were considered a ward and SEMPACC was their political tool. Now, there are no wards but districts. According to the oral history, "There is no SEMPACC anymore. The library is one of the few things left. Its real change because politically the city changed. So now we have different representatives from each Neighborhood association. But at one time, we were all one neighborhood, and we had a lot of political power in city hall." (pg. 21)

The last document from the collection is from the year 1997.

### **SCOPE & CONTENT**

This organization's collection ranges from 1969-1997. The contents are mainly minutes, reports, administrative documents, project notes and research.

The first series is the archivist series. This series is mainly research, notes, redacted and documents that need to be digitized.

The second series is administration and is mainly from the 1980s. It contains basic information about running SEMPACC. It does have information about another collection: Prospect Park Co-op.

The third series is correspondence and ranges from 1975-1997. This contains correspondence that didn't belong in the administration, NRP, or Projects.

The fourth series is Minutes and ranges from 1975-1982. SERAC stands for Southeast Recreation/ Community Education or Southeast recreation community education council.

The neighborhood rehabilitation program was around from the 1970s-1980s. This series includes the information about NRP's Block grants, The university District Improvement Association, and UPDCAC (another university organization). One thing that interested the archivists was the Unified Citizen Participation Plan and other similar initiatives because they wanted an increase of citizen participation.

The sixth series is projects. This series has the earliest documents from 1969. The dates range from 1969 to the 1980s. SEMPACC Sponsored the River Ramble, a glorified block party near St. Anthony Main area.

The seventh series is publications. The collection is from the 1970s to the 1980s. The three most interesting items in this series are: 1) University Stadium project proposal 2) Biking in the Community 3) I-35W proposal.

The eighth and final series is Research. SEMPACC researched three topics. They are schools, MN Opera, and foundation. These folders consist of Clippings, articles, and guides.

The collection is open to researchers and has no restrictions.
